Crime:

Prosecution:

R v Greenbottle Ltd – Revenue and Customs (VAT and Excise Duty fraud involving £100,000 of evasion of VAT and excise duty on manufacture of beer)

Civil:

Personal Injury: both claimant and defendant work undertaken. High volume RTA, slipping/tripping, Occupiers' Liability Act, general factory accidents and industrial injury and disease litigation.

Civil Actions Involving the Police: both claimant and police defendant work undertaken including assault/battery, wrongful arrest and false imprisonment and malicious prosecution.

For Chief Constables, Police Discipline, Regulatory Work. Particular experience in civil proceedings including Inquests following death in custody, firearm and shotgun licence revocation appeals and applications for SOPOs, RSHOs, FTOs, NOs, ASBOs and FBOs.

Common Law Litigation:

Both claimant and defendant work undertaken involving sale of goods, consumer credit, housing disrepair, possession proceedings and building disputes.

Regulatory:

Principally on behalf of Chief Constables including Firearm Revocations Appeals, involving both firearms and shotgun licences, inquest work following death in custody and police disciplinary work.
